## STUDENTS WHO MEET INCOME GUIDELINES MAY QUALIFY FOR SNAP (FOOD STAMPS)!!

Those under income guidelines must meet at least one of the following criteria and cannot be receiving more than 50% of their meals from a school meal program:

- Full-time student who **works at least 20 hours per week** (over 18)
- At least a half-time student who is actively working any hours in a **work-study program**
- Full-time single student who is **responsible to care for a dependent under the age of 12**, regardless of the availability of adequate childcare.
- Full-time **married student, who is responsible to care for a dependent above the age of 5, but under the age of 12** because adequate childcare is not available to enable the individual to fulfill the 20 hour work or work study requirements.
- Receiving **Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)** benefits
- A **less than half-time student** as defined by the institution of higher education
- Full-time **married student who is caring for children younger than**

Those under income guidelines, who meet at least one of the following criteria\*\* and are not receiving more than 50% of their meals from a school meal program are likely to qualify for benefits:

<b>Work-Study</b> (actively working any hours)	
<b>Receiving TANF</b>	
<b>Works at least 20 hours/week</b>	
<b>Custodial parent</b> , who is responsible to <b>care for his or her child(ren) under 12</b> , regardless of the availability of adequate childcare	 <p><i>**You may still qualify, even if you do not meet one of the eligibility criteria listed above. Please call us to find out if you are eligible.</i></p>
<b>Married student</b> , who is responsible to <b>care for his or her child(ren) younger than 6</b>	
<b>Married student</b> and custodial parent responsible to <b>care for his or her child(ren) above the age of 5, but under the age of 12 because adequate care is not available</b> to enable the individual to fulfill the 20 hr. work or work study requirements
